# Alcohol Control Bylaw 2018

The purpose of the bylaw is to reduce crime, disorder and incidents of harm due to the consumption of alcohol in public places.

Every person is prohibited from consuming, bringing into, or possessing alcohol in any public place (including in a vehicle), in the Alcohol Ban Area. This prohibition is effective at all times.

Note: The exceptions listed in section 147(5) of the Local Government Act 2002 apply. These provisions provide certain exceptions for the transport of alcohol in an unopened container and exempt licensed premises from the bylaw.

Every person who commits an infringement offence under section 239A of Local Government Act 2002, and is liable to an infringement fee, \$250.00.

The Police have powers to enforce the bylaw, which include powers of arrest and search. Any person who breaches the bylaw may be liable on summary conviction to a fine
