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Verification timeframes

We will contact you four to six weeks before your verification is next due to arrange a time to meet on site.

We are required by the Food Act to verify you within a short timeframe of your due date so please understand that we can't wait too long to undertake your verification.

We appreciate that there are often other factors which make it hard to schedule a time for us such as staff on leave, owners on holiday etc so please let us know if you are having difficulty.

We contact you early so hopefully something can be arranged at a day/time that works for you but is also within the legal timeframe.

This is your opportunity to have your say and raise matters into the Annual Plan spending.


